The Yeronga State High School Instrumental Music Program is designed to make music accessible, engaging and rewarding for every student.

Program Levy – \$60 per year

A \$60 annual levy supports the cost of sheet music, instrument purchases, maintenance and repairs. There are no additional charges for weekly group lessons or ensemble participation.

Instrument Loan

Students who require an instrument can access one of the school's brass, woodwind or lower-string instruments for use at school and home. The annual \$60 levy includes the cost of a one year school instrument loan.

Students in the Yeronga State High School Instrumental Music Program receive a 30-minute small-group lesson each week, building their skills, confidence and enjoyment of music in our new Instrumental Music Room in P Block.

Music comes alive through performance. All instrumental students are part of a school ensemble, giving them the opportunity to rehearse, perform and connect with other musicians. Ensembles rehearse before school, with regular attendance an essential part of the program and students' musical development.

Students can develop their talents across a range of musical pathways, including band, strings, and jazz.

PERFORMANCES, INCURSIONS AND EXCURSIONS

Performance Opportunities

Students have many opportunities to perform throughout the year, including:

- Semester 1 and Semester 2 Music Showcases
- Queensland Fanfare Music Festival
- School assemblies, including ANZAC Day
- School Fete

Incursions: Guest conductors and performers visit throughout the year to lead workshops and work with students.

Excursions: Students can experience world-class musicians through performances at QPAC and the Queensland Conservatorium.
