Student Expectations:

All students must adhere to school's assessment procedures, located in the Student Planner on page 13.

Attendance:

- In <u>Week 8</u> students who are studying 5 to 7 General subjects will only attend school when they have a scheduled trial exam as per below.
- In <u>Week 9</u> all students will attend their normal timetabled lesson, <u>unless</u> they have a scheduled exam. Students with scheduled exams will only attend school during their exam session and do not attend their normal classes for the day.
- Students who are studying a combination of General, Applied and Vocational Education and Training (VET) subjects will
 attend school in <u>Weeks 8 and 9</u> as per their <u>normal timetable</u>. However, if students have a trial exam for their General
 subject, they will attend the trial exam only on the specified day as per the exam timetable and do not attend their
 normal classes for the day.
- Students are to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of their exam. The time indicated on the schedule is the *commencement* (start) of working time.

Assessment submission for students studying a combination of General, Applied and VET subjects:

- Students who study a combination of General, Applied and VET subject/s are to negotiate with their teacher and/or Head of Department any assessment/s for Applied and/or VET that are due on the same day that they have a trial exam.
- Students who participate in external courses/apprenticeships/traineeships must make arrangements to attend the scheduled trial exams at school. Notify your trainer/employer, the Head of Department of Senior School, Ms Roblin and Senior School Teacher Aide, Ms Griffiths.

Approved equipment for all assessments

- black or blue pen
- 2B pencil, sharpener and eraser
- Note: a 2B pencil is only required for multiple choice questions and drawing graphs or diagrams. Black or blue pen must be used for all other written responses.
- a highlighter
- a clear plastic ruler
- water in a clear unlabelled bottle
- asthma inhaler

You may use a clear plastic container or ziplock bag to carry your equipment if needed.

Students in *Music, Music Extension, Arabic, Japanese, Chinese, German* and *Vietnamese* must bring wired headphones (wireless/bluetooth-enabled earphones and headphones are <u>not</u> allowed).

QCAA-approved calculators


Only calculators approved for use in assessments are permitted. Scientific and graphics calculators must:

- meet the requirements set out in the QCAA Scientific calculator list and Graphics calculator list
- be handheld and solar or battery powered
- be cleared of memory before the assessment/s.

For assessments that permit the use of a non-programmable calculator (Accounting, Economics, Geography, Legal Studies), the calculator must be handheld and solar or battery powered. It must not allow access to the following functions: computer algebra system (CAS), spellchecker, dictionary, thesaurus or translator.
