



Uniform and Dress Code Policy

The P & C of Yeronga SHS supports a student dress code (uniform) for Yeronga SHS because it believes that a student dress code promotes objectives of Education (General Provisions) Bill 2006. In particular, the P & C supports the intention of a student dress code in providing a safe and supportive teaching and learning environment by:

- ready identification of students and non-students at school
- eliminating distraction of competition in dress and fashion at school
- fostering a sense of belonging
- developing mutual respect among students through minimising visible evidence of economic or social differences.

Our student dress code consists of an agreed standard and items of clothing, which are defined as a school uniform that our students wear when:

- attending or representing Yeronga SHS;
- travelling to and from school; and
- engaging in school activities out of school hours.

It is impossible to develop a code to meet everyone's individual requirements, styles or needs. Our school's dress code promotes the good image of the school within the community, and encourages students to uphold and enhance that image, as well as meeting community expectations and health and safety standards. A neat, complete uniform and tidy appearance shows pride in self and school. It projects a positive image to employers and the community.

Yeronga SHS provides excellent educational opportunities for all students and expects that parents will support us in our endeavours by making sure students are well dressed and presented in our uniform everyday for school.

OUR UNIFORM STANDARDS:

DRESS UNIFORM FOR BOYS AND GIRLS - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday

BOYS

SHIRT	Short sleeve Poly/Cotton white with jewel and gold trim on pocket and sleeve
TROUSERS	Black Helder Gab – side and hip pockets
SHORTS	Black Helder Gab – side and hip pockets
BELT	Plain black leather, plain buckle.
SOCKS	Long grey with two jewel stripes
SHOES	Black leather lace-up shoes
TIE	Junior boys tie - green (optional) Senior boys tie – black (Compulsory)
JUMPER	Black V Neck – Jewel & Yellow stripe on the right side
JACKET	Pre-ordered from Uniform Shop ONLY
HAT	Black bucket hat with gold trim. YSHS embroidered on the front, reversible with sports house colour on the inside. Also available YSHS cap.
BLAZER	Black with school logo on front left pocket (optional)

GIRLS

BLOUSE	Short sleeve Poly/Cotton white with jewel and gold trim on sleeve and pocket
SKIRT	Black prestalene - front and back box pleats
LONG PANTS	Black, tailored prestalene
SOCKS	White anklet socks
SHOES	Black leather lace-up shoes
TIE	Junior girls wear button-on tie in jewel OR junior green style longer tie. Senior girls wear the black longer style tie
JUMPER	Black V Neck – Jewel & Yellow stripe on the right side
JACKET	Pre-ordered from Uniform Shop ONLY
HAT	Black bucket hat with gold trim. YSHS embroidered on the front, reversible with sports house colour on the inside. Also available YSHS cap.
BLAZER	Black with school logo on front left pocket (optional)

UNISEX SPORTS UNIFORM - Wednesday only

Worn for sport, physical education and athletics. May be worn to and from school on Wednesdays only, all students.

SHIRT	Panelled Polo – black, gold and jewel Poly/cotton ‘La Coste’, knitted Jacquard collar
SHORTS	Microfibre with taslon stripes – black with jewel and gold stripes on right side and pocket
SKIRT	Black prestalene, front box pleats – jewel and gold strip down right side
SOCKS	White sport socks
SHOES	Black or white sports shoes, suitable for playing sport. No gym boots, slip-on shoes, fashionable/trendy shoes
HAT	Black bucket hat with gold trim. YSHS embroidered on the front, reversible with sports house colour on the inside. Also available YSHS cap
FOOTBALL SOCKS	From the Uniform Shop ONLY

HIJAB: Students may wear black or white hijabs only. Coloured and patterned scarves are not permitted.

Note:

- Parents are reminded that all students must have the correct formal Winter Uniform ready to start Term 2. Please note the following clothing articles are **unacceptable: beanies, denim jeans, cargo pants, track pants.**
- It is a requirement of our school site that all students wear covered shoes for health and safety reasons. Impervious shoes (ie the leather college shoes) must be worn. In particular, activities in Manual Arts, Home Economics and Science require them. Students in Manual Arts may also be required to wear face shields and hair nets whilst operating machinery.

IMPLEMENTATION

Uniform:

Students not in the full & correct school uniform on any day must:

- supply a written note from parent/caregiver giving an adequate explanation as to the reasons why they are out of uniform and detailing when the correct uniform will be obtained.
- this note is to be given to the relevant Year Level Co-ordinator **BEFORE SCHOOL**.
- The Year Level Co-ordinator will enter the infringement in the Student Diary.
- Report to their relevant Deputy Principal if late, after signing in at the office.
- In cases where the alternative is deemed an unacceptable variation or infringement, parents/caregivers will be notified to assist in rectifying the problem.

Accessories, Grooming, Styling:

- A watch, one plain ring, fine gold/silver chain, one pair of plain ear sleepers or studs are sufficient and appropriate jewellery for school wear. This limit on jewellery is for obvious health/safety reasons and for the prevention of possible loss of such items.
- No facial piercings or facial hair.
- At all times appropriate grooming styles that reflect community and health & safety standards apply – clean, neat and tidy. Excessive make-up, coloured nail polish other than natural/pastel tones and excessively coloured, outlandish hairstyles (this includes mohawks, unnatural colours etc) are not acceptable. Any accessories, grooming or styling which are deemed:
 - offensive
 - likely to disrupt, or negatively influence normal school operations
 - unsafe for student or others
 - likely to result in a risk to health and safety of student or others are not permitted.

Free Dress Day Standards:

Standards for free dress days are as follows:

- Covered shoes
- No singlets
- No midriffs showing
- Accessory, grooming and styling standards apply

Sun Safety:

It is recommended that whenever students are in the sun, they use the approved forms of sun protection, ie. UV 30+ sunscreen and a hat, both available from the Uniform shop. For all Physical Education classes conducted in the sun, and for students representing the school at sporting events, a cap or hat should be worn.

NON-COMPLIANCE

At Yeronga SHS we impose sanctions on a once only basis per episode of non-compliance. Our sanctions are reflective of the severity and recency of the non-compliance and are limited to one of the following:

- Imposing a detention for a student during lunch or after school (if after school, inform parents before detention occurs);
- Preventing student from attending, or participating in, any activity for which student is representing school; or
- Preventing student from attending or participating in any school activity that is not an essential school educational program.

In resolving matters of student dress codes, the school considers:

- Mobile families requiring sufficient time to purchase items of dress;
- Economic hardship requiring special arrangements, or an extended period of time, to purchase new items of dress;
- Students with physical impairments requiring greater flexibility in interpretation of dress codes; and

We provide our Student Dress Code policy to parents at the time of enrolment as part of the Enrolment Package. The Yeronga SHS community is very proud of its uniform and we encourage parents/caregivers to support the school by upholding our fair and reasonable dress standards.
